- To be active as an International Referee (IR) by being available for a minimum of 1 BISFed sanctioned tournament at least every 2 years *.
 - AND have been active within your National member country over the previous 2 years as Referee, Head Referee, or Assistant Head Referee, at a National tournament * (Logbook evidence required).
- Have refereed a minimum of 10 International Matches at a BISFed sanctioned (or Paralympic) Tournament in the previous 2 years* (Logbook evidence required).
 - OR Have been a Head Referee or Assistant Head Referee at a BISFed sanctioned tournament within the previous 2 years* (Logbook evidence required).
 - (Unless you were not selected for any of your nominated tournaments because more IRs were nominated than needed for those years).
- 3. O If an IR is selected to attend a tournament but then cannot go, BISFed must be informed as soon as possible, with the reason why. BISFed will inform the Referee Committee.
 - If the same situation is repeated twice during a period of 4 years, without justifiable reason, International Referee status may be revoked.
- 4. Be willing to undertake evaluation at BISFed competitions and to act on the feedback given (including further training).
- 5. O Be able to make a measurement, to stop a ball and to do the Referee Gestures / signs (IRs with a disability will need to show capability to instruct another Technical official to carry out the procedure).
- 6. Keep up to date with Rule changes and with the International Referee Procedures Manual.
- 7. Abide by BISFed's Code of Ethics.
