

Entry Fee

1200€ (accommodation in twin en-suite rooms, all meals from dinner 2th April to breakfast 10st April, transport from/to Zagreb Airport, daily transport from hotel to venue and back)

950€ - for players coming only to the individual competition (accommodation in twin en-suite rooms, all meals from dinner 02th April to breakfast 07th. April, transport from/to Zagreb Airport, daily transport from hotel to venue and back)

750€ - for players coming only to the teams and pairs competition (accommodation in twin ensuite rooms, all meals from dinner 06th April to breakfast 10st April, transport from/to Zagreb Airport, daily transport from hotel to venue and back)

Please note that any athlete requiring classification must arrive on the 02th April.

Extra costs for single rooms is 320€

The following staff are permitted:


- 1 Team Leader
- 1 Medical/Technical
- 1 Coach per Team/Pair
- 1 Assistant per Athlete

Any additional staff must be approved by HOC and will be charged a one-off fee of 300€ on top of the entry fee.

Refunds

If an athlete withdraws at any point after 1st entry deadline, full previous payment will be withheld by the HOC until after the event to assess what can be returned e.g. if the HOC receives refunds for the late cancellation of accommodation, meals or transport.

If an athlete is forced to withdraw for legitimate medical reasons at least one week before the tournament, full payment will be returned. If this happens less than a week before the tournament, at least 50% of full payment will be returned, but we will do our best to get back as much as possible.








Hotel is located 15km from Airport, 3km from Venue and 2km from main city square.

<u>Meals</u>

First Meal Provided – Dinner on day of arrival

Last Meal Provided – Breakfast on day of departure

Breakfast and Dinner will be served in the hotel, Lunch will be served in the venue.

The competition schedule will not include lunch breaks, so lunch will be served over a long enough period to allow everyone to eat during the day.

It is the responsibility of each country to advise the HOC of any special dietary requirements as part of the final entry.



<u>Visas</u>

Please ensure you apply in a good time to obtaine Visas. The HOC will support where is possible, but cannot help if a Visa application is not made in a good time.



Transport

At arrival and departure, the HOC will ensure transportation for all delegations and officials from Zagreb Airport to the Hotel and from the Hotel to the Airport. To guarantee the correct functioning of transport services, it is essential that the transport form is completed with the maximum accuracy, considering flight numbers, terminals, and times with details about additional equipment, number of wheelchairs, whether manual or electric, as well as motor wheelchair motorcycles or bath chairs.

During competition the HOC will ensure transportation on the route Hotel – Venue- Hotel. Detailed schedule of transportation will be available in the hotel lobby and the information desk at the venue.

We also offer transportation from Vienna Airport and Budapest Airport in agreement with HOC. This transport requires timely notification to the HOC.

The cost of transport from Vienna Airport and Budapest Airport is borne by the teams themselves.

Insurance

Each team must attend the Event with their own medical and travel insurance to cover loss of property, injures or medical treatment, travel disruption or luggage loss.

WorldBoccia and the Regional Open HOC will accept no responsibilities for injuries or loss of wages due to injuries.

Doping control

Doping control will take place at the competition.



Covid protocol
