Accommodation

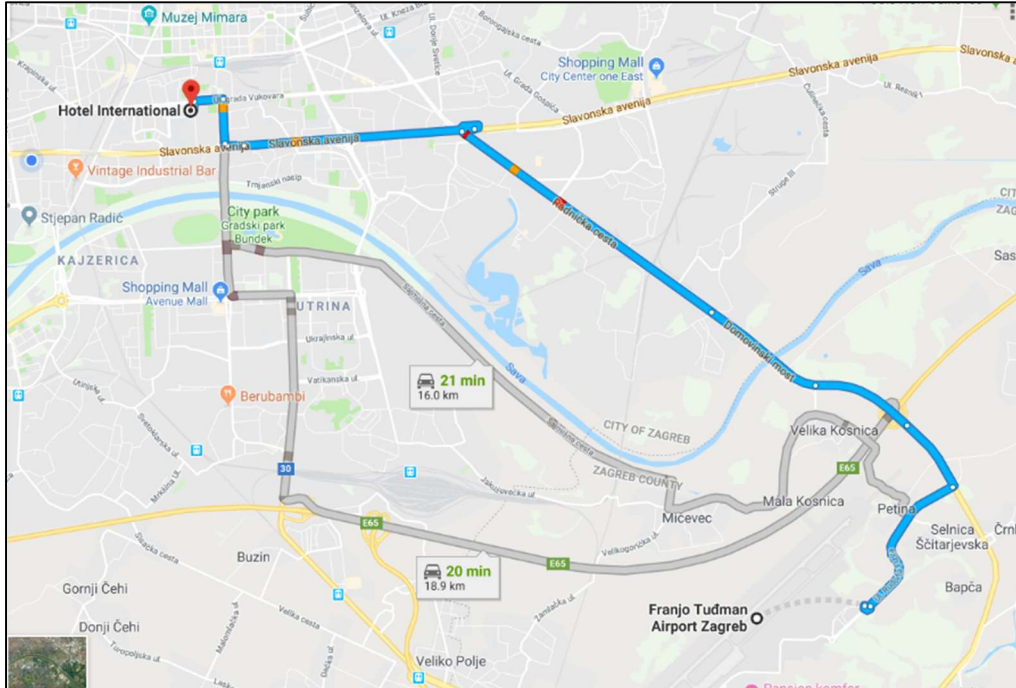

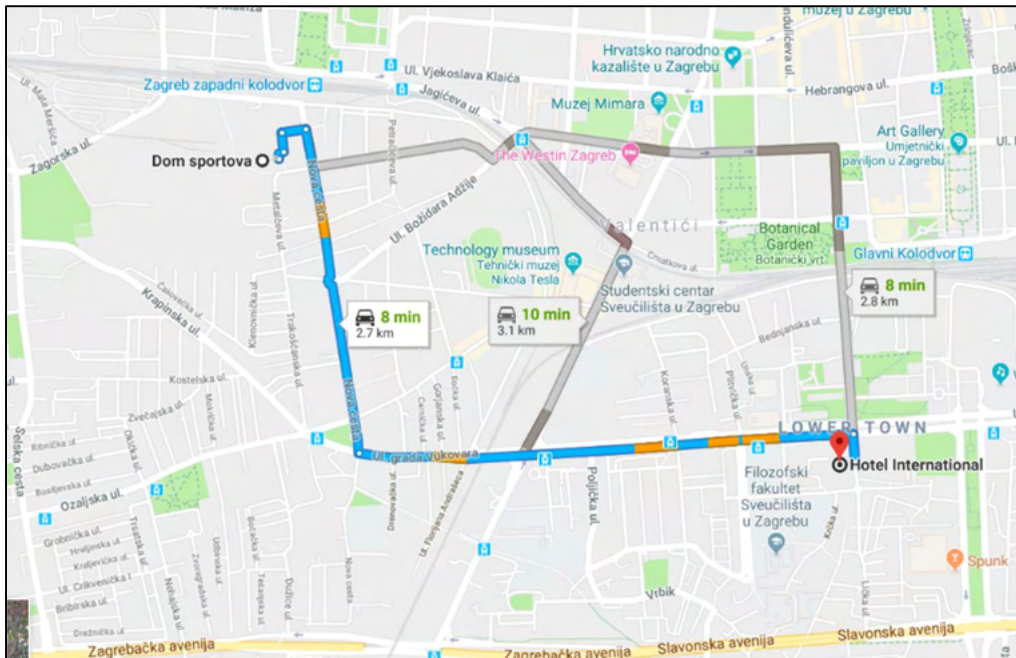
There will be one wheelchair accessible room available to book for showers at reception.

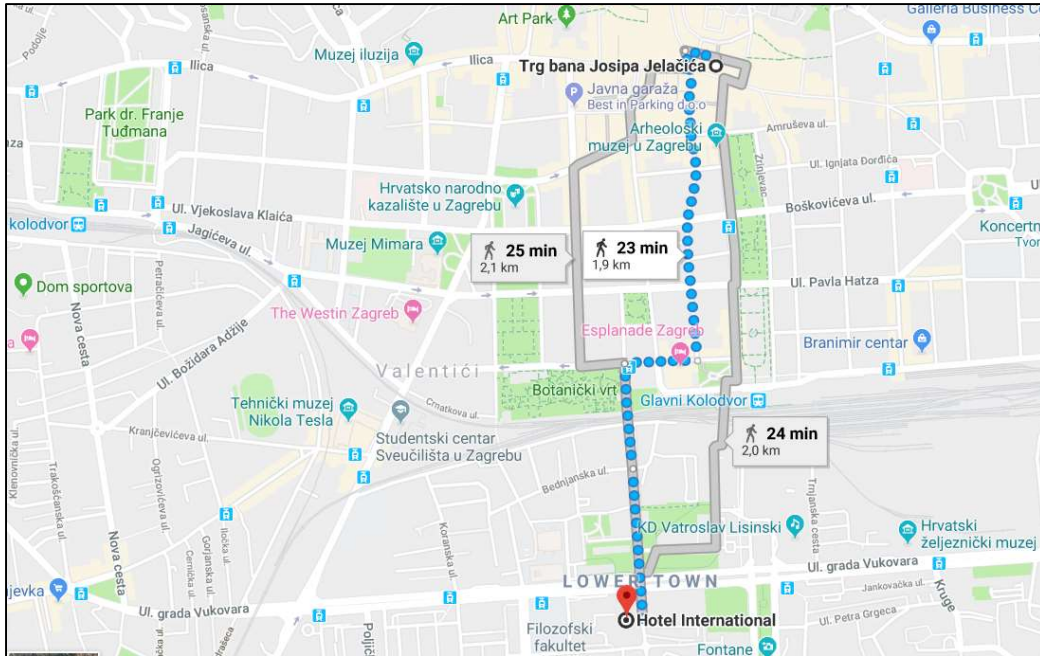
Airport to hotel

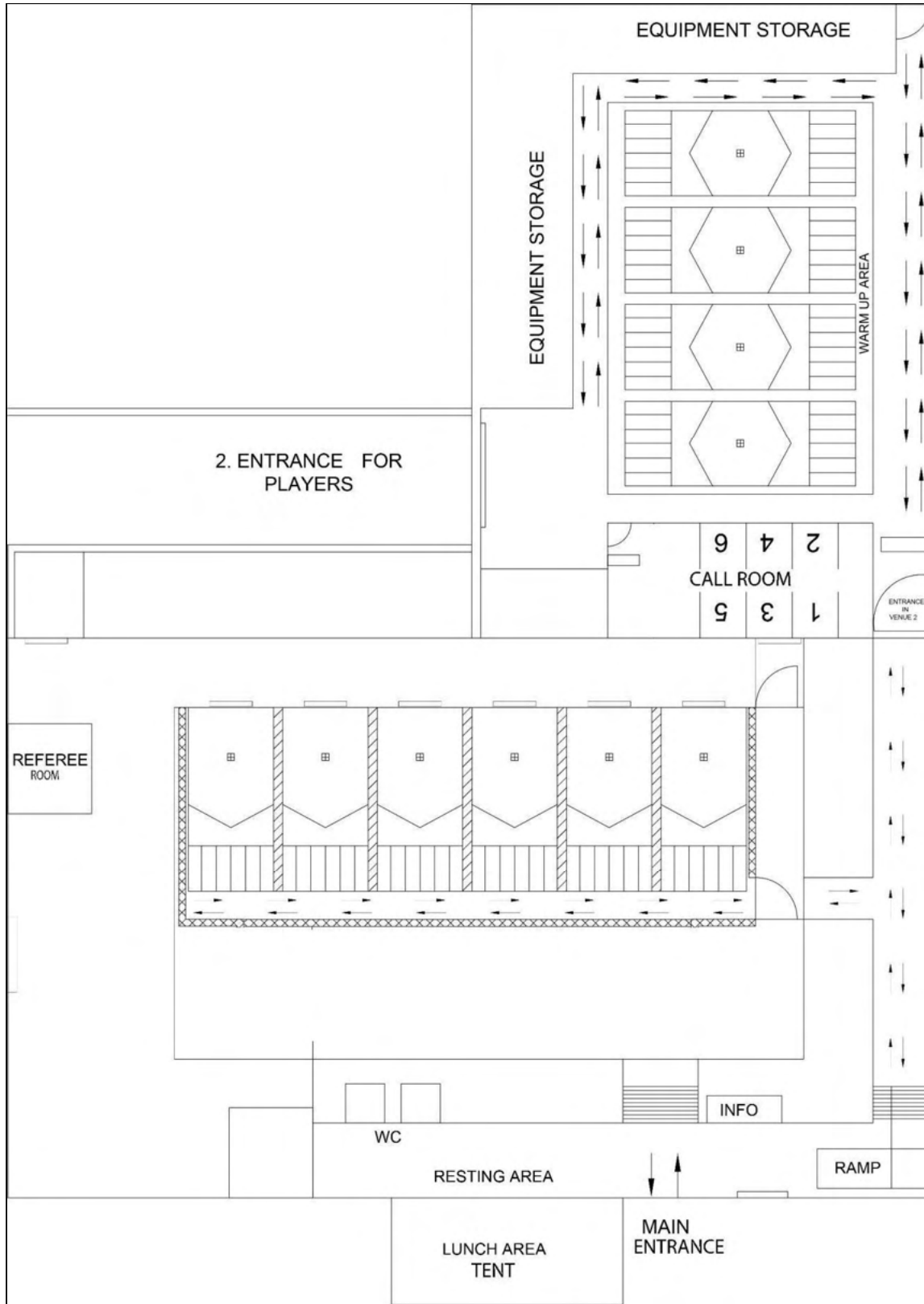

Uniform colour

Classification

Athletes to be classified must bring their Passport (or Identification Card) to their classification appointment. In addition, the athletes must sign, in the presence of a witness, the BISFed Consent for Classification Form. Please ensure that the athletes understand the document, provide translation if necessary and bring the form to classification.

Athletes must bring a list of all medications and any pertinent health information written in English with them. They must also bring the Certificate of Diagnosis completed by their medical doctor.

The athletes must come to classification with Boccia equipment used in play and be dressed in sports clothing. If they are not properly attired they will not be classified. Classification will take place on the call room.

Training Schedule

Training on competition courts will be available on 2nd and 3rd April.

All countries have been allocated one slot of 120 minutes on FOP. On 3rd April there will be available training on the warm-up courts.

Countries with three or less athletes have been allocated one Court, countries with four to seven athletes have been allocated two courts and countries with eight to ten athletes three courts.

The teams must be at the entrance of the competition area at least 5 minutes before the scheduled time. They must stop training five minutes before the finish time and prepare their equipment to vacate the court at the scheduled time.

Access to the entrance of the training area will be allowed only to accredited staff or athletes who are scheduled for training.

Closing Ceremony will take place in the venue on the 9th April, after the Medal Ceremony.



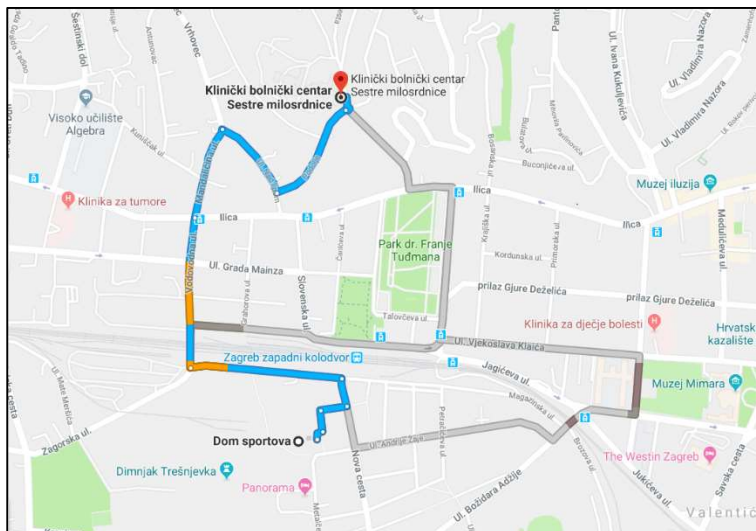
Insurance and Medical

All participating nations must arrange medical and accident coverage including repatriation insurance for the entire length of their stay. The insurance should cover all athletes and staff.

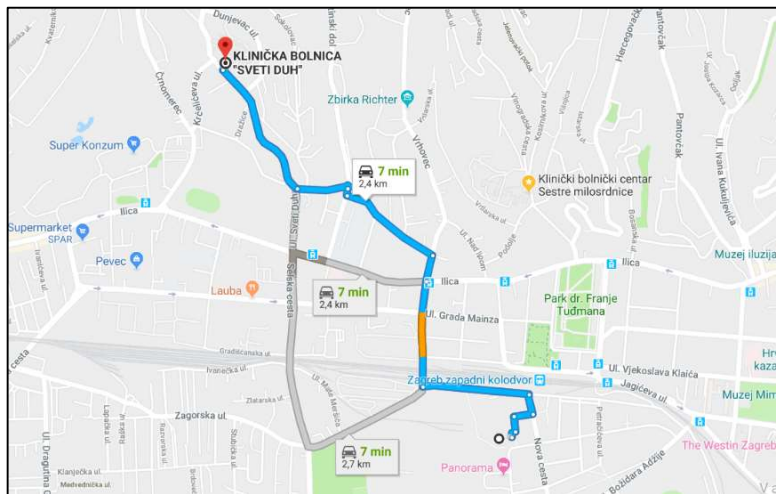

Currency

Currency in Croatia is Kuna (HRK) and it is only available currency in Croatia.

We recommend that you change your money in one of the currency exchange offices around the city. One is located right next to the hotel.

COVID Protocol

A negative PCR test not older than 72 hours on arrival is mandatory for all participants. The HOC will follow the Covid measures from the National Health Authority and WorldBoccia.

All participants will be tested on COVID on April 7 in the Venue.

In Croatia, face masks are mandatory in all enclosed public spaces and in public transport. Please make sure you have enough masks for the entire duration of the tournament.

At the entry to the competition venue all participants must pass a temperature check. Any individual with a temperature above 37,5°C will be reported to the HOC and will not be permitted to enter the venue or participate in the event further unless and until a negative test result for COVID-19 is produced. He/she will be sent to the isolation room and Health Authorities will be notified.

Report to the Covid Official any suspicion that a team member presents symptoms of COVID-19. The individual and any team members with whom he/she has been in close contact must also isolate and will only be allowed back to the competition on production of a negative COVID-19 test after the relevant local incubation period.

If you notice a suspicion that you are infected while in the venue, notify the Covid Official immediately. She will refer you to further procedures.

If you notice a suspicion that you are infected while you are at the hotel, immediately inform the hotel reception, which will refer you to further procedures.

All participants suspected of being infected will be isolated in their hotel room. If there is a need to stay in the hotel after April 10, they pay the costs of the extended stay.

If you want / need to take the COVID test before going home, please inform us in advance at info@hsbi.hr or do it no later than the day of arrival at the information desk at the hotel.
