# World Boccia Heraklion Challenger 2023



## 1. Anti-Doping Procedures

Competitors taking part in the Challenger may be subject to random doping control. The Anti-Doping control / processes will be carried out in full accordance with the 2021 Anti-Doping Code <https://www.wada-ama.org/en/resources/world-anti-doping-program/world-anti-doping-code> and the BISFed Anti-Doping Rules 2021 [https://www.worldboccia.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/01/BISFed-Anti-Doping-Rules-2021\\_Final-1.pdf](https://www.worldboccia.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/01/BISFed-Anti-Doping-Rules-2021_Final-1.pdf), with the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) and National Anti-Doping Agency (E.O.KA.N) policies and procedures.

The following doping control tests will be carried out at the Event:

- 2 non-Competition anti-doping tests will run on October 21<sup>st</sup>
- 4 Competition anti-doping tests will run on October 25<sup>th</sup>

World Boccia Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) form and the list of prohibited substances can be found on the World Boccia website.

## 4. Transportation

### a. Arrivals & departures

On official arrivals and departures days, such for those teams requested early arrival, transport will be provided to official hotel from Nikos Kazantzakis International Airport.

The HOC will schedule transport based on the information provided on the Sport80 Platform.

The HOC will not be able to provide transport if a team did not provide the information in the Sport80 Platform

HOC will have a Welcome Desk at Nikos Kazantzakis International Airport.

### b. Accommodation Transport

On training and competition days transport will be provided from hotel to the venue with priority to the first matches and training

Transport will also be provided from the venue to the hotel every hour between 4:00pm and 7:00pm on competition days

## 5. Meals

- Breakfast – Hotel: 6:30am early breakfast for the first matches  
7:30-10:30 All delegates
- Lunch – Venue: 12:00pm – 3:00pm
- Dinner – Hotel: 6:30pm – 9:30pm

*First meal: dinner on the day of arrival*

*Last meal: Breakfast on the day of departure*

## 6. Insurance, Health & Medical Assistance

Participants will be responsible for the cost of any medical treatment required by them during the Event (except of emergency and first aid treatment on-site at the Event) including transportation to a suitable hospital or other medical facility.

Participants must obtain adequate medical insurance (to include repatriation cover) prior to participating in the Event.
