ANTI-DOPING

- **Anti-Doping Procedures**

- Please be advised that this Event is subject to anti-doping testing in accordance with the policies and procedures of **World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA)** regulations and **Autoridade Brasileira de Controle de Dopagem (ABCD)**.
- Therefore, there will be, at minimum, the following doping control tests to be carried out at the Event:
 - 02 non-Competition anti-doping tests will run on **May 31st**.
 - 04 Competition anti-doping tests will run on **June 04th**.
- The list of prohibited substances can be found on the World Boccia website (<https://www.worldboccia.com/documents/#AntiDopingDoc>). All doping processes will be in accordance with the procedures of the WADA.
- World Boccia Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) forms are located on the World Boccia website. Athletes, who are using banned substances found on the WADA Prohibited List for therapeutic reasons, should complete the TUE forms and return them to the World Boccia doping officer.

- **World Boccia Rules & Regulations**

- All events of the São Paulo 2024 World Boccia Cup will run in accordance with World Boccia International Boccia Rules, World Boccia Competition Rules, Competition Guide, World Boccia World Ranking and World Boccia Code of Ethics. In case of doubt or disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the English version shall prevail. The current World Boccia Boccia Rules can be found on the World Boccia website.
- Any case not included in this document shall be solved in accordance with the Technical Delegate.
- It is the responsibility of each World Boccia Member participating in the Event to ensure that all competitors and staff are familiar with World Boccia Boccia Rules as well as the World Boccia Code of Ethics.

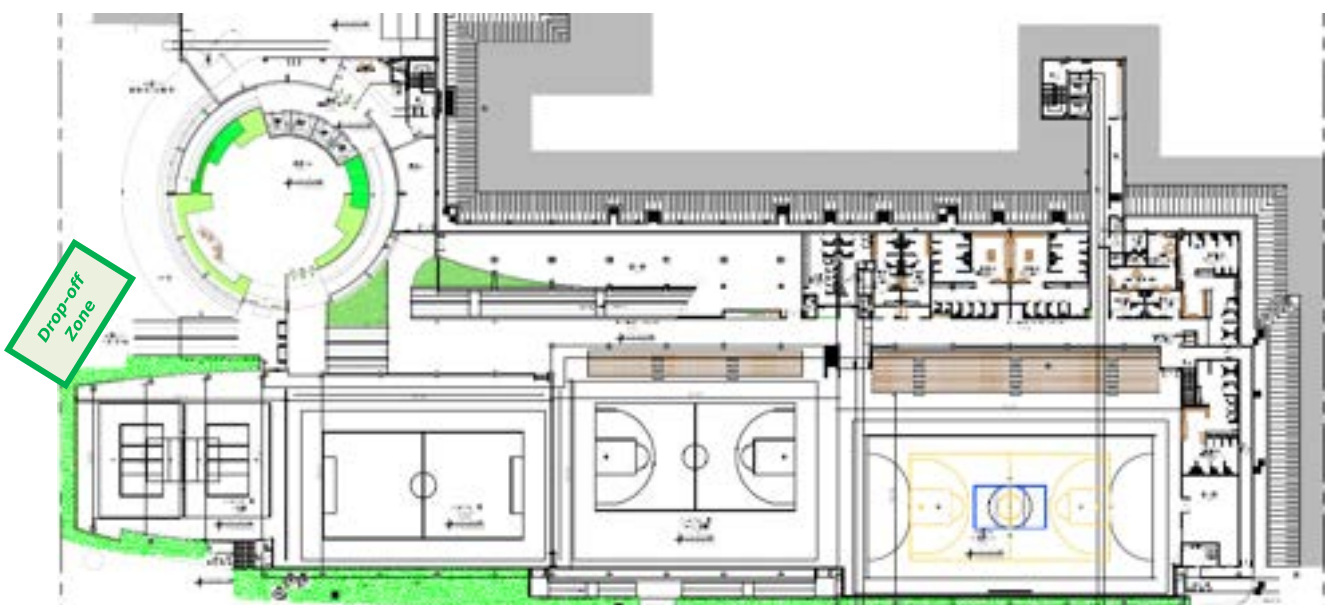

2. Coming from the Residencial – The access will be the same.

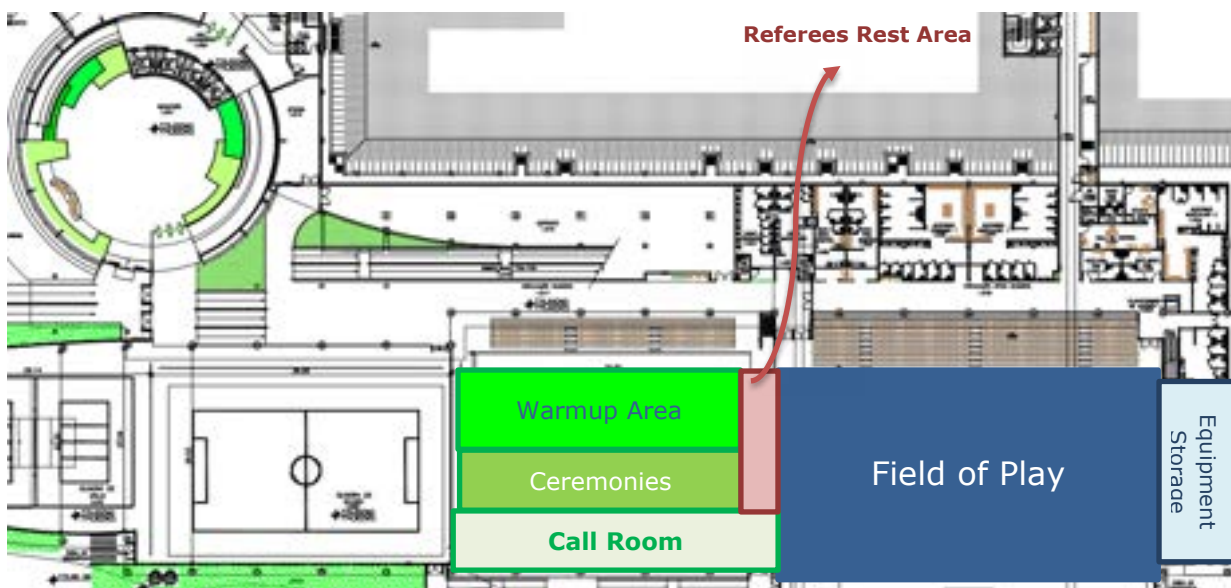


COMPETITION VENUE



Competition Venue – Arena

- Stands for 400 spectators.
- 08 competition courts will be marked.
- 04 warmup/training courts will be marked.
- Equipment Storage – Beside the FOP. Looking for it – in the left.
- Call Room – In the Warmup Area – beside the FOP. Looking for it – in the right.
- Equipment Check Room - At the Call Room.
- Official’s Room – Between Warmup Area and FOP.
- Classification Room – 2nd floor.
- Doping Control Room - 2nd floor – beside the Classification Room.



CLASSIFICATION

May 30th

Classification Room – 2nd Floor:

- Room 01 – Next Doping Control Room - Near the Swimming Pool.

Important Notice: All athletes to be classified or reclassified must have submitted their updated Certificate of Diagnosis and Consent Form for Classification before the Event at World Boccia Platform or to saopaulo2024boccia@ande.org.br.

Athletes:

- Must provide a document such as a Passport, ID card, Boccia License Card or Event Accreditation.
- Must sign an Informed Consent Form which states that the athlete must comply with all reasonable instructions given by a Classification Panel.
- Must attend the Evaluation Session with sports attire and equipment relevant to Boccia for which the athlete wishes to be allocated such as ramps, pointers and gloves or splints.
- Have the right to be accompanied by a member of the athlete's National Body or National Paralympic Committee when attending an Evaluation Session.

MEDAL CEREMONY

The Medal Ceremony for Individual Competition will be held on June 4th, 30 minutes after the last match of the day at the **Warmup Area**.

The Medal Ceremony of Team and Pairs' Competition will be held on June 6th, 30 minutes after the last match of the day at the **Warmup Area**.

The HOC kindly asks the medallists to be ready for the Medal Ceremonies 15 minutes before its starts. The Call Room will be used as preparation area for the ceremonies.

The HOC reminds the medallists that it is **NOT** allowed to bring any kind of objects to the podium.

Only people that receive a Medal will be allowed at the Podium while Medals are being presented. After the Anthem the assistant/coach may approach the Podium for a brief moment to take pictures with their athletes.

COMPETITION UNIFORM COLOURS

COMPETITION

The countries eligible to compete at the São Paulo 2024 World Boccia Cup must have paid all entry fees in full, submitted all required registration information and are currently full members of World Boccia.

Divisions of Play

Individual BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4 (Male & Female) and Pairs BC3, Pairs BC4 and BC1-BC2 Teams.

Competitor Numbers (BIBs)

- Upon confirmation of classification, each athlete shall be given one (1) piece of competitor number, to be used as follows:
 - The BIB must be worn at all times during the hours of competition. The competitor number must be attached to the front of the shirt or the trouser leg;
 - For classes BC1 and BC3, the assistant/ramp operator will have a second competitor number.
 - BC1 assistant: the BIB must be attached on his/her front;
 - BC3 ramp operator: the BIB must be attached on his/her back.
- If an athlete forgets, loses, or chooses not to wear their competitor number, he/she will not be permitted to enter the warm-up area, the Call Room or the field of play.

A side that is not present for the start of the match forfeits the match (rule 7.4). Exceptions may be considered by the Head Referee and/or the Technical Delegate.

Pre-Game Preparation:

A - Warm-up Area Procedures

- From the 01st of June on, warm-up area is exclusive for the competitors that are going to play next.
 - Warm up area will be available for the athletes who will play in a round at the same time as the Call Room closes for the previous round.
 - For the first round of the day, the warm-up will run in the FOP.

- Warm-up for Individuals starts 90 min before the Schedule time of the Match and finishes 5 min before the call room opens.
- Warm-up for Teams and Pairs starts 105 min before the Scheduled time of the Match and finishes 5 min Before the call room opens.
- Players may be accompanied into the warm-up area by a maximum number of people as follows (Rule 6):

- If necessary, a translator and a physiotherapist/masseuse per Country may enter the warm-up area, however they can't help or assist with coaching.

B - Call Room Procedures

- Prior to entering the Warm-up Area and Call Room, each Athlete, Sport Assistant and/or Ramp Operator must show their competitor bib numbers and their accreditation tag. Coaches (or Coaching Assistants) must show their accreditation (Rule 7.3).
- A Side must be registered between forty-five (45) and twenty (20) minutes before the scheduled start time of any Team/Pairs match. A Side must be registered between thirty (30) and fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled start time of any Individual match (Rules 7.4.1 & 7.4.2). Registration is done at the Call Room Desk. A Coach may only register an individual athlete if that athlete is at the entrance to the Call Room area.
- Each Side (Individual, Team, or Pair, including any SA/RO and the Coach/CA) must register together and must bring all their equipment and balls with them (Rule 7.4.3).
- The Official Clock is the Venue digital clock. Any Side who fails to register, or be registered, within the above time limit will automatically be disqualified. If the

Side fails to be present within the above time limit, it will forfeit the match (Rule 7.4).

- Once registered and inside the Call Room, athletes, coaches, and sports assistants must not leave the Call Room. Should they do so, they will not gain re-admittance and will take no further part in the match, potentially forfeiting the match. The number of people, as indicated below, may accompany sides into the Call Room. Translators are not subject to this restriction. However, they may only enter the call room if asked to do so by the Referee.
