- **Anti-Doping Procedures**

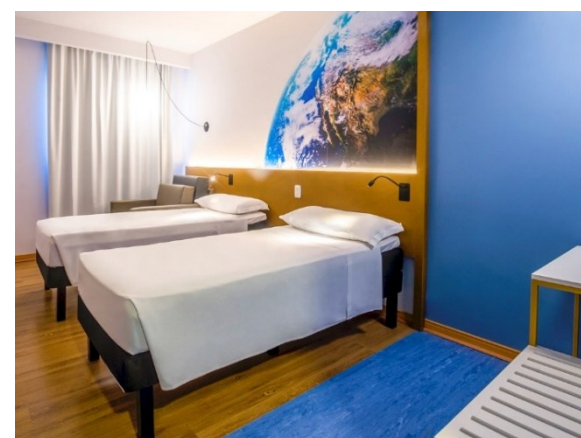
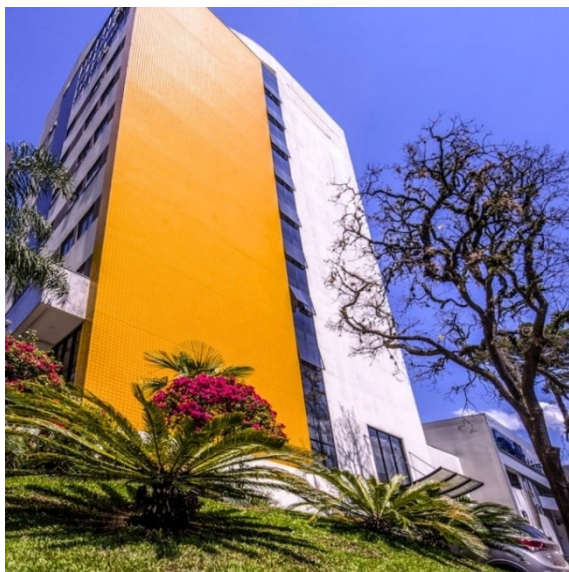
- Please be advised that this Event is subject to anti-doping testing in accordance with the policies and procedures of **World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA)** regulations and **Autoridade Brasileira de Controle de Dopagem (ABCD)**.
- Therefore, there will be, at minimum, the following doping control tests to be carried out at the Event:
 - 02 non-Competition anti-doping tests will run on **March 24th**.
 - 04 Competition anti-doping tests will run on **March 28th**.
- The list of prohibited substances can be found on the World Boccia website (<https://www.worldboccia.com/documents/#AntiDopingDoc>). All doping processes will be in accordance with the procedures of the WADA.
- World Boccia Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) forms are located on the World Boccia website. Athletes, who are using banned substances found on the WADA Prohibited List for therapeutic reasons, should complete the TUE forms and return them to the World Boccia doping officer.

- **World Boccia Rules & Regulations**

- All events of the Curitiba 2025 Youth World Boccia Championships will run in accordance with World Boccia International Boccia Rules, World Boccia Competition Rules, Competition Guide, World Boccia World Ranking and World Boccia Code of Ethics. In case of doubt or disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the English version shall prevail. The current World Boccia Rules can be found on the World Boccia website.
- Any case not included in this document shall be solved in accordance with the Technical Delegate.
- It is the responsibility of each World Boccia Member participating in the Event to ensure that all competitors and staff are familiar with World Boccia Rules as well as the World Boccia Code of Ethics.

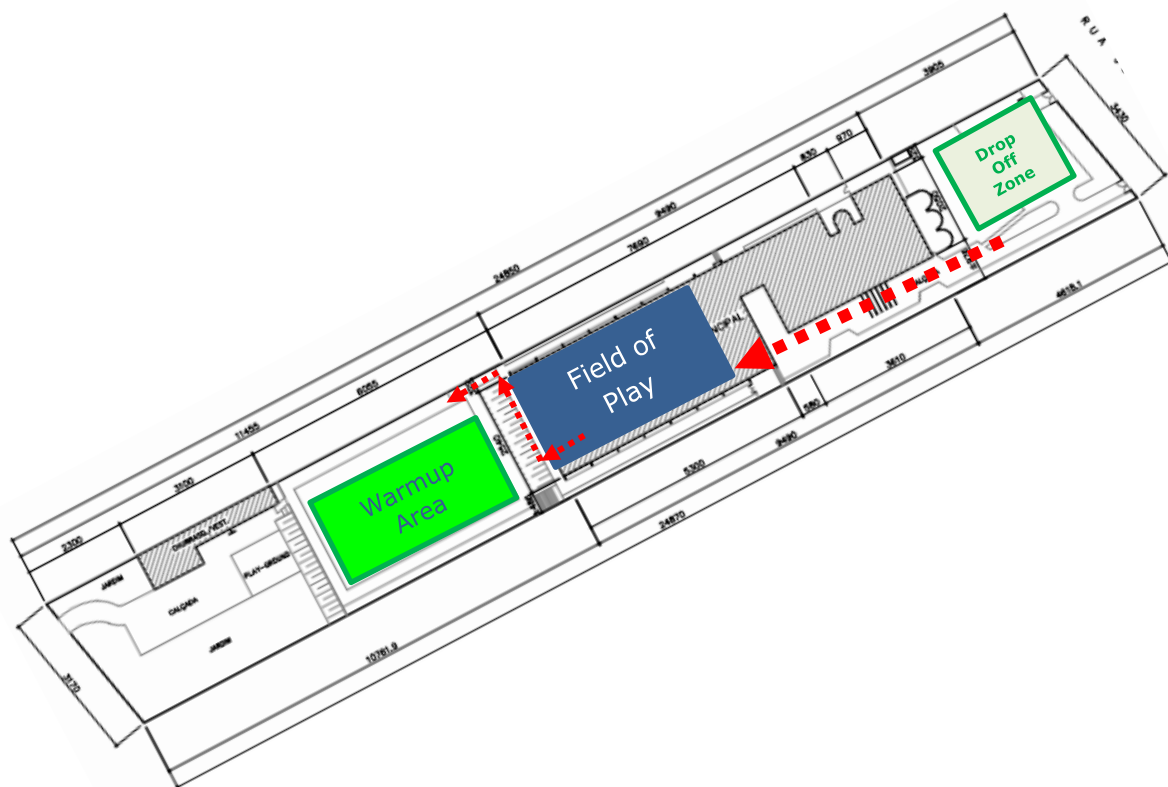

Important Notice: All athletes to be classified or reclassified must have submitted their updated Certificate of Diagnosis and Consent Form for Classification before the Event at World Boccia Platform or to curitiba2025boccia@ande.org.br.

Athletes:

- Must provide a document such as a Passport, ID card, Boccia License Card or Event Accreditation.
- Must sign an Informed Consent Form which states that the athlete must comply with all reasonable instructions given by a Classification Panel.
- Must attend the Evaluation Session with sports attire and equipment relevant to Boccia for which the athlete wishes to be allocated such as ramps, pointers and gloves or splints.
- Have the right to be accompanied by a member of the athlete's National Body or National Paralympic Committee when attending an Evaluation Session.
- Must provide information to the Classification Panel regarding impairment medication, medical device/implant, and any surgery that affects sport performance.
- Must arrive at Classification Room 20 minutes prior to his/her Evaluation Session.

OPENING CEREMONY

The Opening Ceremony will be held on March 25th at 5:00pm at the Competition Area.

MEDAL CEREMONY

The Medals Ceremonies (Individual' and Team and Pairs' Competition) will be held on March 29th, 30 minutes after the last match of the day at the **Competition Area**.

The HOC kindly asks the medallists to be ready for the Medal Ceremonies 15 minutes before its starts. The Call Room will be used as preparation area for the ceremonies.

The HOC reminds the medallists that it is **NOT** allowed to bring any kind of objects to the podium.

Only people that receive a Medal will be allowed at the Podium while Medals are being presented. After the Anthem the assistant/coach may approach the Podium for a brief moment to take pictures with their athletes.

COMPETITION UNIFORM COLOURS

Athletes (and Teams & Pairs) must have two different uniform colours to compete. In case of a colour clash between two opposing sides, the athlete (Team or Pair) with lower position in the World ranking will be required to wear their secondary uniform. According to the information registered at the World Boccia Platform, the uniform colours will be allocated as follows:

EQUIPMENT CHECK

- Equipment Check will be done on **March 25th** at the Competition Venue. Equipment that does not meet the criteria will not be certified and will be held by the organization until the end of the championship.

- Keep in mind that "All **BC3 Sports Assistants** are required to bring their passport to the equipment check in order to confirm Nationality eligibility according to the World Boccia Policy - Nationality of competitors" **and they must be from the same country as the athlete.**

Training on the Competition Courts

- Five minutes before the finish time, teams must stop training and prepare all the equipment to leave at the scheduled time.

COMPETITION

The countries eligible to compete at the Curitiba 2025 Youth World Boccia Championships must have paid all entry fees in full, submitted all required registration information and are currently full members of World Boccia.

Divisions of Play

Individual BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4 (Mixed) and Pairs BC3, Pairs BC4 and BC1-BC2 Teams.

Competitor Numbers (BIBs)

- Upon confirmation of classification, each athlete shall be given one (1) piece of competitor number, to be used as follows:
 - The BIB must be worn at all times during the hours of competition. The competitor number must be attached to the front of the shirt or the trouser leg;
 - For class BC3, the assistant/ramp operator will have a second competitor number.
 - BC3 ramp operator: the BIB must be attached on his/her back.

- If an athlete forgets, loses, or chooses not to wear their competitor number, he/she will not be permitted to enter the warm-up area, the Call Room or the field of play.

A side that is not present for the start of the match forfeits the match. Exceptions may be considered by the Head Referee and/or the Technical Delegate.

Pre-Game Preparation:

A - Warm-up Area Procedures

- From the 26th of March on, warm-up area is exclusive for the competitors that are going to play next.
 - Warm up area will be available for the athletes who will play in a round at the same time as the Call Room closes for the previous round.
 - For the first round of the day, the warm-up will run in the FOP.
 - Warm-up for Individuals starts 95 min before the Schedule time of the Match and finishes 5 min before the call room opens.
- Players may be accompanied into the warm-up area by a maximum number of people as follows (Rule 6):

BC1	1 Coach (or 1 Coaching Assistant), plus 1 Sport Assistant
BC2	1 Coach (or 1 Coaching Assistant), plus 1 Sport Assistant

Team (BC1/2)	1 Coach (or 1 Coaching Assistant), plus 1 Sport Assistant

- If necessary, a translator and a physiotherapist/masseuse per Country may enter the warm-up area, however they can't help or assist with coaching.

B - Call Room Procedures

- Prior to entering the Call Room, each Athlete and each Ramp Operator must show their competitor bib numbers and their accreditation tag. Coaches must show their accreditation. The Competitor's number must be clearly visible from the front and may be fixed to the competitor or the wheelchair. ROs must wear the bib number that corresponds to the Athlete they are assisting, clearly visible

on their back. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in entry being refused to the Call Room.

- Registration for all matches is done at the Call Room desk, which is at the entrance to the Call Room. A Side that is not present in the Call Room on time will forfeit the match.
- For all divisions, all Athletes must be registered between thirty-five (35) and twenty (20) minutes before the scheduled start time of a match in which they are scheduled to participate.
- Each Side (Individual, Team or Pair, including any SA/RO and the Coach) must register together and must bring all their equipment and balls with them. Each Side should bring to the Call Room only the items necessary to compete. **An exception may be made for Coaches who are on court in back-to-back matches and are not able to register in time at the Call Room entrance for a consecutive match.**
- Once registered and inside the Call Room, Athletes, Coaches and SA/RO may not leave the Call Room. Should they do so, they will not be allowed to re-enter and will not take further part in the current match (rule 7.12 an exception). Any other exceptions will be considered by the (assistant) Head Referee and/or the Technical Delegate.
- All Sides must remain in the Call Room in their designated court area immediately after they have registered. If an Athlete needs to play back-to-back games, the Coach/CA or Team Manager may, with the TD's permission, register the Athlete for the following game. This includes playoff games when the Athlete's progression to the next level does not leave enough time to comply with Call Room time constraints.
- Players may be accompanied into the Call Room by a maximum number of people as follows

Chairs will be provided for Translators, outside of the Call Room and in a specific place on the field of play (FOP).
