IMPORTANT: Teams must be at the entrance of the competition area (**beside courts exit**) at least 5 minutes before scheduled time. Training must stop 5 minutes before session ends. Teams are responsible for preparing to vacate the court on time. Access to the training area entrance is allowed only for accredited staff or athletes on the schedule.



COMPETITION

Countries eligible to compete at the Póvoa de Varzim 2026 World Boccia Cup must have paid all entry fees in full, submitted all required registration information and are currently full members of World Boccia in good standing.

DIVISIONS OF PLAY

- Individual: BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4 (Female & Male)
- Teams BC1-BC2
- Pairs BC3
- Pairs BC4

COMPETITION NUMBERS (BIB)

Each athlete will receive two competitor numbers (BIBs) – one to wear and one spare. They will be distributed at the Technical Meeting on July 5th.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES

PRE-GAME PREPARATION

Warm-Up Schedule [Rule 6.1]	
Opening Time	Closing Time
95 minutes before the scheduled start time	40 minutes before the match begins [5 minutes before the Call Room opens]

PROCEDURES

Starting from July 6th, 2026, the **warm-up area will be reserved exclusively for competitors who are scheduled to play next.**

Athletes may be accompanied in the warm-up area by a **limited number of support personnel**, in accordance with Rule 6.2, as follows:

BC1	1 Coach + 1 Sport Assistant
BC2	1 Coach + 1 Sport Assistant
BC3	1 Coach + 1 Ramp Operator
BC4	1 Coach + 1 Sport Assistant
Pairs BC3	1 Coach + 1 Ramp Operator per Athlete
Pairs BC4	1 Coach + 1 Sport Assistant
Teams (BC1-BC2)	1 Coach + 1 Sport Assistant

If necessary, a **translator** and a **physiotherapist/massage therapist** per country may enter the warm-up area. However, they are not permitted to assist with coaching or provide any form of competitive support.





CALL-ROOM PROCEDURES

PRE-GAME PREPARATION

Call Room Schedule [Rule 7.4.1]	
Opening Time	Closing Time
35 minutes before the scheduled start time of the match	20 minutes before the scheduled start time of the match
Each Side (Individual, Team or Pair, including any SA/RO and Coach/CA) must register together and bring all their equipment and balls with them. Each Side should bring to the Call Room only the items necessary to compete.

PROCEDURES

Athletes may be accompanied into the Call Room by the **following maximum number of people** [Rule 7.2]:

BC1	1 Coach + 1 Sport Assistant
BC2	1 Coach

BC4	1 Coach (+ 1 Sport Assistant if Athlete is a foot player)
Pairs BC3	1 Coach + 1 Ramp Operator per Athlete
Pairs BC4	1 Coach + 1 Sport Assistant (if Athlete is a foot player)
Teams (BC1-BC2)	1 Coach + 1 Sport Assistant

Important: In accordance with Rule 7.4.3, Sides may only enter the Call Room wearing the correct uniform colour. This must be the primary uniform colour, unless there is a colour clash with a higher-ranked opponent, in which case the secondary uniform colour must be worn.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE STRUCTURE

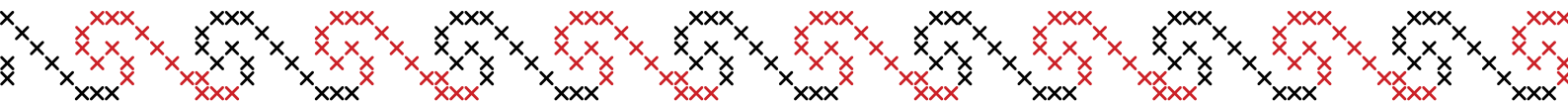
The final competition schedule will be released after the **Official Individual Competition Draw**, which will take place on **July 1st at 13:00** (Portuguese time).

Once finalised, the schedule will be shared with all Team Managers or designated representatives.

If there are any athlete withdrawals up until July 5th, a partial draw for the relevant sport class may be conducted at the Technical Meeting, and a revised version of the competition schedule will be published after the meeting.
